CueThink is available through a web browser on all devices, including iPads, ChromeBooks, laptops and desktops. Students can seamlessly switch between devices.



CueThink automatically created your class rosters and student accounts. Students can simply login and begin. View your class rosters in the [Roster > Classes](#) page.


Starter Assignments
