## **Accessing CueThink**

CueThink is available through a web browser on all devices, including iPads, ChromeBooks, laptops and desktops. Students can seamlessly switch between devices.


Use Google Chrome, Firefox or Safari 11+ to bookmark and access CueThink via app.cuethink.com or the login button on cuethink.com. Use sign in with Google option.

### **Setup Your Class**

- Go to <u>Roster > Classes</u>. Use the +New Class button to create your class(es.)
- There are 2 options to roster students. Watch these videos:

  - o <u>Import roster</u> from Google Classroom


#### **Starter Assignments**

- Scavenger Hunt: A fun way for students to explore CueThink.
  - Go to Assignments > Problem Bank page. Choose **CueThink Problems** folder.
  - 2 Type "**Scavenger Hunt**" in the Search bar.
  - 3 Click **Assign** in the right panel





- **Getting Started Folder:** Tasks with multiple entry points and opportunities for mathematical modeling.
  - Go to Assignments > Problem Bank page. Select the *Getting Started* folder.
  - 2 Choose a problem.
  - (3) Click **Assign** in the right panel.
